

SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS MILES HILL FARM LLC

- Ride at your own risk.
- Helmets, proper boots, and long pants required when mounted.
- All participants, mounted or unmounted, must have a signed liability waiver.
- Clean up after yourself and your horse.
- Don't leave your horse unattended on cross ties.
- If you open a gate, kindly close it behind you.
- No smoking anywhere on the property.
- Please, no dogs.
- Children under the age of 13 require adult supervision.
- Remove halters from horses in stalls and in turnout areas.
- Vehicles are to be parked in the designated parking areas. No driving in and/or parking in the barn area without permission.
- In an emergency, a vet will be called at your expense if you cannot be reached, or if you fail to take appropriate measures.
- Ring courtesy should be recognized. When riding on the rail, pass left shoulder to left shoulder.
- Board is due on the 1st of the month, and is late by the 5th of the month. The late charge is \$25, and if board and late fee are not received by the 6th of the month, they will automatically be charged to your credit card on file.
- Any loss of or damage to equipment is not the responsibility of Miles Hill Farm, its management or employees.
- Jumping is only allowed during instruction for riders less than 18 years, unless express permission is granted by Management.
- Actions such as stealing, use of narcotics, flagrant damage or destruction of stable property, abuse of animals, physical or verbal abuse of MHF personnel or any other actions which are deemed detrimental to MHF will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate expulsion from the premises.
- Direct loss, damage or injury to your horse, tack, equipment or trailer is not covered by MHF insurance while on these premises. You as the owner of these personal property items have financial interest in same, therefore it is up to you to be sure that they are insured under a homeowner's, tenant's, or other insurance policy, or under a separate policy as in the case of loss, injury, damage or death of a horse.
- In cold weather, the hose must be drained after use.
- Horses that crib must wear a cribbing collar.

- Turn off the lights when you leave.
- No alterations may be made to the barn or stalls. This includes signs, hooks, racks, pictures, etc.
- The arena is used on a first come first serve basis. Everyone can co-exist and use it at once but be respectful of who is riding (children etc). If you wish to lunge your horse while someone else is riding please ask to make sure it will not bother the other horse.
- Do not use other's equipment without their permission.
- Do not give horses extra feed, shavings, or hay without the management's permission.

Farm hours are 7:30AM until 9:30PM.
